It was directed to place the AQAR 2021-22 in the ensuing Planning and Monitoring Board meeting, for further approval.

The committee suggested to initiate the necessary steps to automate the data capturing procedure for NAAC and NIRF to ensure easy data collection, collation and analysis with coherency and consistency. Further, it was reminded that the development and deployment of Learning Management System (LMS) for GRI has to be initiated immediately.

It was suggested that the Deans / Heads / Directors should motivate the students to enroll in on-line certificate courses of NPTEL, Spoken Tutorials, etc. to ensure maximum participation.

It was decided to initiate the preparation of Self Study Report of GRI for the Fourth Cycle of NAAC Accreditation.

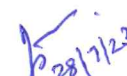
The IQAC members recommended that the designation of present Guest teacher / Part-time teacher be changed as Lecturer (temporary) / Lecturer (contractual) / Lecturer (Adhoc) or similar so that the strength of those teachers can be accounted for the computation of student staff ratio as well as in other criteria of assessment and accreditation ranking, in favour of the institute.

It was recommended that the seed money for research shall be sanctioned every year to Assistant Professors of our institute to foster research culture among them.


It was recommended that the special initiatives and measures immediately taken to raise corpus fund and alumni fund for augmentation and development of infrastructure of the institute.


The Registrar, i/c assured that the necessary and essential support will be extended to ensure quality assurance and sustenance.

The meeting of IQAC began with a silent prayer. The Director, IQAC, welcomed the members of the IQAC internal committee.

The meeting started with a briefing of IQAC activities and progress by the Director, IQAC, followed by detailed discussions on NIRF-2024 filing and NAAC – 4<sup>th</sup> Cycle Accreditation process. After a detailed deliberation, the following decisions were made for further action towards NIRF-2024 filing and NAAC – 4<sup>th</sup> Cycle accreditation.

1. Intend for NIRF was successfully submitted through NIRF online portal on 05.10.2023 and it was further decided to collect relevant information from various Schools / Departments / Centres / Administrative section at the earliest for submission in the NIRF portal once it is open.
2. Since NAAC was overdue since September 2021, a Road map with a tentative time-line for NAAC – 4<sup>th</sup> Cycle Accreditation processes was prepared. **(Details in Annexure-I)**
3. Recommend to ensure complete automation of administration at all levels.

4. Recommend to the authorities to strengthen Ph.D. process including thesis evaluation progress and tracking system with MIS to ease scholar's tracking of Ph.D. status.

**Action: Academic Section / Examination Section / Computer Centre**

5. In accordance to the UGC guidelines, NEP 2020 must be implemented from the present academic year (2023-24). All academic units must prepare a new curriculum in compliance with NEP 2020.

**Action: Academic Section / All Schools / Departments / Centres**

6. The committee recommend to the authorities to change the designation of Guest Teacher / Part-time Teachers to Lecturer (Temporary) / Assistant Professor (Temporary) in line with NIRF guidelines.

**Action: Establishment Section**

7. Completion of CAS promotion to Teaching staff and DPC for Non-Teaching (pending if any) & Direct Recruitment of teaching and non-teaching (Filling-up the backlog vacancies)

**(Action: Establishment Section)**

8. Overall infrastructure development including renovation of buildings, upgrading classroom facilities and laboratory facilities, hostel facilities, signboards, creation of additional classrooms and road laying, Clean and Green Campus including proper waste disposal etc.

9. The committee recommend to take appropriate measures to scrap unusable material and furniture from Schools / Departments / Centres / Sections to create a better ambience at the work place.

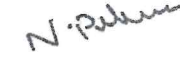
